

Cape Fear Corvettes
Minutes of July 1, 2008, membership meeting

- The meeting was called to order at approximately 7:00 PM by CFC president Oz Brau.
- New members in attendance were welcomed and all in attendance were introduced.
- Oz reviewed the upcoming (July 20) SCCA Auto-cross event and invited members to participate, either as competitors or as spectators.
 - Everyone who plans to attend needs to pre-register in order to gain admittance to the Marine base.
 - (Please notice that a Corvette is now prominently displayed on the event flyer).
- The proposed Sept. 21 Corvette show at JGC was outlined by Oz:
 - The JGC dealership will provide only one trophy, the "Dealer's Choice"
 - The show must be held on a Sunday, when the dealership is normally closed
 - The JGC new car building will be opened to allow access to restrooms, shelter
 - JGC will clear the front parking lot to provide parking for show vehicles
 - All expenses must be supported by entrance fees, donations or CFC funding
 - Expected expenses include trophies, dash plaques, flyers, DJ, +?
- Many alternatives were discussed: judged show, display only, prizes, t-shirts, fees, etc.
- It was agreed that a working show committee is urgently needed to "git-'er-done!" on time. Volunteers were recruited and the list currently includes:
 - Dana Fox – Chair, Tony Caracciolo, Bill Bordwine, Phil Eames, Bill Trussell, Joe Craig, Tom Walsh and Oz Brau. Others are also needed.
- Several suggested show features were also discussed and need follow-up:
 - Radio station broadcasting from show location?
 - Police participation: "DARE" (like Leland show)?
 - Military participation: HUM-V?
 - JGC/Chevrolet display: 427, ZR1, Race Car?
 - DJ?
 - Food vendors?
- Ideas were solicited for upcoming CFC cruises:
 - Fort Fisher military recreation area and restaurant (Oz will check)
 - Andy's on Gordon Road
 - Restaurants at Mayfair
 - New PT's Grille at Magnolia Greens (scheduled to open Friday July 4).
- Oz reviewed the CFC membership benefits proposed by JGC dealership (see website for details).
 - Included is a "tech day" for members to meet with dealership service technicians to discuss service issues, repairs, trouble-shooting, etc.
 - CFC members are also eligible for special club discounts at many auto parts and service locations.
 - Show your CFC membership card and ASK before your pay.
